### A BRIEF NOTE ABOUT THE SCHOOL

### D.A.V. GROUP OF SCHOOLS, CHENNAI – AN OVERVIEW

The Dayanand Anglo Vedic (DAV) movement was started by the Arya Samaj way back in 1886 in Lahore (currently part of Pakistan). Against the backdrop of a society riddled with superstitious practices and beliefs, the Arya Samaj emerged as an active advocate of education for all irrespective of gender or caste. Thus, DAV - the first organised schooling system by Indians in that era, was established in memory of Swami Dayanand Saraswati, a versatile genius, social reformer, educationist, benefactor of humanity and harbinger of the national movement.

- 'D' Dayanand (Swami Dayanand Saraswati)
- 'A' Anglo (signifying contemporary education)
- 'V' Vedic (Shaastras based education with blend of spirituality)

The far-sighted founders of DAV – Lala Lajpat Rai, Mahatma Hansraj, Pandit Gurudutt Vidyarthi and many others emphasised that education should be holistic with a judicious mix of Vedic (Paraa Vidya) and Contemporary subjects (Aparaa Vidya).

### Arya Samaj in Chennai

Following the partition of India in 1947, many followers of Vedic dharma were among those forced to move from Pakistan to India with some settling down here in Chennai, where they recreated the DAV movement and founded the **Tamil Nadu Arya Samaj Educational Society (TNAES) in 1970.** 

Some of the key founders include Lala Indersain ji, Shri Satyadev ji, Shri Jaidev ji, Shri Balakrishna Joshi ji, Shri Ram Kalia ji, Shri Surendra Kumar ji, Shri VN Bajaj ji, Shri Balakishan Goenka ji, Shri DC Malhotra ji and Shri SD Nangia ji. They continue to inspire the next generations through a service-oriented Board and management who work on an honorary basis.

### Education - Reach

Started with just 50 students under a banyan tree at Gopalapuram, the DAV Group of Schools today serves over 40,000 students across 10 Owned schools, 5 Managed schools (3 Public & 2 Private) and 23 Academic Associates.

**Owned Schools** - TNAES governs eight full-fledged schools located across Gopalapuram, Mogappair, Gill Nagar, Pallikaranai and Puducherry. Two Government-aided schools function out of Sowcarpet and Vyasarpadi.

Managed Schools (Public & Private) – TNAES partners with existing and new schools in both the Public and Private sectors. Currently, the Society manages three schools for BHEL - one at Ranipet and two at Tiruchirappalli as well as two Private schools - DAV Sarada Eshwar Vidyalaya in Pozhichalur and DAV-SM Fomra School at Kelambakkam.

**Academic Associates** - Drawing from the institution's collective experience over the last 50 years, this service-oriented initiative is a unique advisory model to share best practices with schools across the country that share a similar vision and are driven by the larger purpose of nation-building.

The initiative aims to help improve the quality of education beyond metropolitan cities and currently works with 23 Academic Associates across Gobichettipalayam, Kallakurichi, Karur, Madurai, Mayiladuthurai, Salem, Tirupur, Vellore, Kovilpatti, Chengalpattu, Gingee, Kanchipuram, Chittur, Karimangalam, Dharmapuri, Chidambaram, Namakkal, Srimushnam, Neyveli, Mannargudi, Coimbatore, Melmaruvathur and Trichy.

The recently formed **National Admissions Test (NAT)** department focuses on helping and hand holding students to clear various entrance examinations like CLAT, CA, CUET, KVPY, IAPT, NTSE, NDA, NID and more, thus enabling them to gain admission to courses of their choice at eminent colleges and universities of excellence.

Career Guidance Programs are regularly conducted online to share real-time information and guidance by reputed alumni and successful professionals across various domains so that students are well-informed to make the right choice.

## **Holistic Learning**

**DAV Krida Kendram** – **The Sports Academy** strives to help all stakeholders, including teachers and parents, gain a sense of sportsmanship and a passion in **Sports, Yoga and Self-defence.** In addition to after-school training programs, workshops and inter-DAV competitions, the Academy also hosts numerous events like State Level Basketball Championships and an International Chess Tournament amongst others.

A professional training program has also been introduced to help aspiring PE teachers gain competence.

**DAV Kala Kendram -The Creative Arts Academy** has been set up to encourage learning and participation in **Performing, Visual and Literary Arts.** The academy promotes both contemporary and traditional art forms and comprises of theory and practical classes, workshops, competitions and more.

### VALUE-BASED (Spirituality & Service)

The institution rests on a strong foundation of Dharma (Spirituality) and students are encouraged to follow the Vedic way of life through

the Panch Maha Yajna – the 'Five Daily Duties' that include respecting and taking care of elders, guests, the environment and animals.

Guided meditation and Agnihotra continues to be conducted regularly at schools and children can also celebrate their birthdays by performing



Agnihotra. 'Namaste', a respectful way of greeting which means 'The I in me bows to the I in you' and addressing teachers as 'Aacharya' are inbuilt in the school culture.

Developing **Service orientation** is an integral part of Dharma. Therefore, to inculcate in children a sense of gratitude, compassion, empathy and an appreciation for the dignity of labour, the **Sushrusha** programme was introduced wherein students interact with children with special needs, visit old age homes, orphanages, Goshalas and learn to **serve with humility**.

The 'Pillars of DAV' - a committed group of stalwarts including the Founders, worked selflessly and tirelessly to create an educational model to impart good values and foster academic excellence while ensuring that high quality education is accessible to all. Thanks to all of them, it became possible for DAV Chennai to remain a not-for-profit organisation in true spirit, providing subsidised education and impacting thousands of students every year.

#### OTHER EDUCATIONAL INITIATIVES BY TNAES

**Teacher Training** - With "Acharya Devo Bhava" being one of its guiding principles, DAV Shikshanam was established in the year 2017 with its flagship teacher training program, 'Post Graduate Certificate in Education (PGCE)'. Aspiring teachers are given intensive job-oriented training along with practical exposure across DAV school branches.

**Publishing** - In pursuit of excellence in academics and to provide rootedness in our culture, this in-house division publishes textbooks that follow Indic-culture and are affordable, contemporary and value-based. Subject videos which will help students revise topics at their own pace is produced by the e-Shiksha Paathshaala team. Prajya - a thoughtfully curated National news magazine for children is published every month.

**DAV - SM Fomra Civil Services Scholarship Program** - In keeping with our commitment towards nation building, the DAV-SM Fomra Civil Services Scholarship program was launched in 2022. Civil

service aspirants from across Tamil Nadu and Puducherry are shortlisted for this intensive residential program that includes mentoring and academic support by reputed faculty, free boarding facilities and performance-based stipends.

#### **ARYA SAMAJ FOUNDATION (ASF) - VISION HEAL**

**Arya Samaj Foundation** - the parent body of the DAV Group of Schools, Chennai, aims to empower and improve lives in keeping with the sixth Principle - "To do good to the world by improving the physical, spiritual and social conditions of mankind".

#### Recent Initiatives:

#### A BRIEF NOTE ABOUT THE SCHOOL

D.A.V. Matriculation Higher Secondary school, Gill Nagar was established in the year 1999, with class XI on a plot of land measuring 3 grounds and 126 square feet, gifted by Smt. Parma Devi Goyal, w/o Late O.P. Goyal and her family members. Classes I to IX were added in the year 2003 and the kindergarten classes in 2007. The school now has 1095 students, 50 teaching and 21 non-teaching staff.

With the aim of ensuring quality access to learning for children with special needs, the school has evolved into an inclusive school. It focuses on helping students attain self-reliance by removing the barriers that limit participation.

The school has adequately equipped laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer science and a well stocked library. Our students are also a part of the NEET and JEET courses that is being held at our Mogappair and Gopalapuram branches. Most of our students get into reputed institutions for Engineering, Medicine, Law and Para Medical courses. Many of our students from the Commerce stream groom themselves into Lawyers and Chartered Accountants.

Sports and games are an integral part of the activities in school. The school playground sprawls to about 10 grounds. We have standard courts for throw ball and volley ball. Training facilities are available for students of D A V and non-D A V schools in chess, football, athletics, volley ball and silambam through our Krida Kendram. Our students represent in various sports at the Zonal, District, State and National level. Inter house games and sports build in our students a sense of sportsmanship and competitive spirit.

#### **CURRICULUM AND LANGUAGE SCHEME**

**For classes I and II:** English, Languages, Mathematics, Drawing, Painting, Craft, Value Education, Theatre, Yoga and Physical Education are compulsory.

**For classes III to V**: English, Languages, Mathematics, Environmental Studies, Drawing, Painting, Craft, Value Education, Computer Science, Sloka, Theatre, Yoga and Physical Education are compulsory.

**For classes VI to VIII**: English, Languages, Mathematics, Science, Social Science, Drawing, Painting, Craft, Value Education, Mental Ability, Life Skills, Computer Science, Theatre, Yoga and Physical Education are compulsory.

**For classes IX and X :** English, Tamil, Mathematics, Science, Social Science, Value Education, Computer Science, Yoga, Digital Art and Physical Education are compulsory.

#### Subjects in Classes XI & XII

I Group: Tamil/Sanskrit, English, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology.

II Group: Tamil/Sanskrit, English, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Computer Science.

III Group: Tamil / Sanskrit, English, Commerce, Accountancy, Business Maths. Economics.

### **SCHOOL UNIFORM**

#### **BOYS**

Classes LKG - III: Grey shorts, half sleeved white and grey checked shirt with the school monogram stitched on the left pocket of the shirt, Black shoes (model and brand prescribed by the school) and Black socks.

Classes IV & V: Grey shorts, half sleeved grey and white checked shirt with school monogram stitched on the left pocket of the shirt, Black shoes (model and brand prescribed by the school), Black socks and school belt.

Classes VI & VII: Grey shorts, half sleeved grey and white checked shirt with school monogram stitched on the left pocket of the shirt, Black Vegan sports shoes on the days of PET period, Black shoes (model and brand prescribed by the school), Black socks and school belt.

Classes VIII - XII: Grey full trousers (baggy trousers not allowed) half sleeved grey and white checked shirt with school monogram stitched on the left pocket of the shirt, Black Vegan sports shoes on the days of PET period, Black Shoes (model and brand prescribed by the school), Black socks and school belt.

**PET Uniform :** School Pants, House T-Shirt and Sports shoes (model and brand prescribed by the school)

#### **GIRLS**

Classes LKG & UKG: Grey and White checked blouse, grey 'A' line frock, Black ribbon / Black hair band, Black socks, Black shoes (model and brand prescribed by the school). School monogram has to be stitched in the centre of the 'A' line frock.

**Classes I to V**: Grey pinafore, grey and white checked blouse, Black shoes (model and brand prescribed by the school), Black socks, Black ribbon / hair band. School monogram should be stitched on the left sleeve of the grey blouse.

Classes VI to XII: Grey salwar, grey and white checked kameez, grey waist coat, Black Shoes (model and brand prescribed by the school) Black socks, Black ribbons / hair band. School monogram has to be stitched on the left sleeve of the kameez.

#### **HOUSES**

To facilitate all round development and to build a spirit of competition, the House system is followed. All our students belong to one of the four houses, Ganga, Kaveri, Narmada and Krishna. Inter house competitions in sports, cultural and literary activities are a part of the school program. Our students have been a part of various teams at the Zonal, District, State and National levels.

### **CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

Physical Education, Art & Craft, Music, Moral Education, Theatre, Digital Arts and Yoga, form an integral part of the school curriculum. Debating, quizzing, essay writing, short story writing, elocution, dramatics are a part of our literary club activities. The students are encouraged and provided with opportunities to participate in various inter-school competitions. Educational Tours and Field Trips are a part of the activities that provide opportunities for children to explore and understand more from their experiences.

The school leaves no stone unturned to help the children develop into citizens that the country would be proud of.

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- Attendance on the last working day and reopening day is compulsory. An extended holiday along with any vacation will not be condoned.
- 2. A pupil may avail leave only with prior permission except in unforeseen cases. In case of an eventuality, the pupil will have to ensure that the leave application reaches the office or the class teacher be informed on the first day of absence. Students will not be permitted to enter the class without a letter from the parent in this regard. Parents are requested not to apply for leave for their wards along with the holidays already declared by the school or an extended holiday during weekends.
- All leave applications exceeding two days are to be addressed to the Principal by the pupil's parent/guardian, while application for short durations of two days or less are to be addressed to the class teacher or entered and also endorsed by the Class Teacher in the given format in the calendar.
- 4. Any pupil availing sick leave shall be required to produce a medical certificate and a prescription signed by the doctor.
- Late coming to school should be strictly avoided. Habitual late coming is punishable. Habitual late comers shall not be allowed to attend school.
- 6. In case of unauthorized absence for 10 days or more the student's name will be removed from the rolls.
- 7. Pupils requiring leave during any part of the day, whatever be the reason, will have to obtain the Principal's permission in person, supported by a written request from the parent. Pupils will be permitted to go only with the parent / guardian.
- 8. Every pupil is required to have an attendance of not less than 85% of the working days in a school year, failing which the chances of promotion to the next class is doubtful.

- 9. Absenteeism on days preceding the Examinations or Periodic Tests shall be viewed seriously. The parents shall explain the reason to the Principal, in person.
- Parents should ensure that their ward/s are present for all examinations.
- Academic dishonesty (Adopting Malpractice for academic work like in record work, projects, class tests, examinations etc.) shall warrant severe punishment. Also, in very serious cases, at the discretion of the Principal, the candidate who is found guilty will be issued with the TC.
- 12. Physical Education is compulsory for all pupils up to Class XII. Students having less than 80% of attendance to PE classes, may not be considered for promotion.
- Students shall be assigned suitable places in the class room by the class teachers and the students will have to adhere to the same.
- 14. Parents are requested to send packed lunch only through their wards. The watchmen have been strictly instructed not to collect the lunch bags or any other material from anyone, including parents for security reasons.
- 15. Students are not permitted to carry non-vegetarian food to school.
- 16. Dispersal: The school gates will be opened to parents and escorts of students of LKG at 12.10 pm, UKG at 2.10 pm, classes I to V at 2.20 p.m., and for students of Class VI to XII at 3 p.m. Parents are requested to ensure that their ward/s leave the school on time.
- 17. Parents are to ensure that the students carry only the Text books, Notebooks and other materials required, for that day along with them WITHOUT FAIL. Students are discouraged from carrying anything that is not required for the day.

- 18. Students must strictly adhere to the school norms for proper turn out, which include belt, clean shoes & socks, clean & short nails and trimmed hair for the boys. Girls have to tie their hair (two plaits) braided neatly with black ribbons. Any default will lead to strict disciplinary action.
- 19. Students are expected to co-operate in keeping the premises of the school neat and tidy and therefore refrain from scribbling on the walls and littering. Any objectionable practices like damaging the furniture, dirtying the floor or spitting in corners shall be viewed very seriously.
- Students shall greet one another and their teachers with a traditional "Namaste" and their behaviour towards elders shall be marked with respect and obedience.
- 21. On a teacher entering the classroom the students shall rise and remain standing till they are advised to sit by the teacher. At the end of the class, when the teacher leaves, the students shall rise again, express gratitude and resume their seats quickly. The classes will commence and end with a brief silent prayer.
- 22. The class leaders, deputy leaders and all students shall willingly extend their cooperation with obedience inside the classroom, at every school function inside and outside the premises.
- 23. The School Pupil Leader, the Assistant School Pupil Leader, the House Captains and the House Vice-Captains and other Council Members who constitute the School Prefect Council will help the authorities on matters of discipline and administration.
- 24. Students are expected to exhibit exemplary behaviour at all points in time inclusive of the short break, the long recess etc.
- 25. (a) Periodical Progress Reports shall be sent to parents or guardians to appraise them of the student's regularity, conduct and work at school.

- (b) Any student who does not return the progress report within two days duly signed by the parent or guardian shall not be allowed to attend classes.
- (c) Any student who tampers with the progress report or is found guilty of any other malpractice in this connection is liable to face severe disciplinary action.
- (d) Any parent wishing to communicate to the school, based on the progress report sent to him is requested to make a separate communication to the school. Parents are advised not to enter any remark in the report card.
- 26. Whenever a call goes to the parent from the school in connection with the child's work or conduct at school, he/she will kindly make it a point to respond to it in the interest of the child.
- 27. Parents are expected to go through the School diary of their ward everyday for any information sent by the school and acknowledge the messages sent by affixing their signature in the appropriate place. They are also requested to adopt the measures recommended by the school in the best interest of the child.
- 28. No student is permitted to bring any money to school unless a written note is sent by the teacher. Whenever money is sent, the parent should insist on an acknowledgement for the same from the teacher.
- 29. No student or group of students or members of students' association / clubs are permitted to collect any funds in cash or cheque from any internal or external source. The parents are advised to warn their children against any collection. Any violation of this rule will be strictly dealt with.
- 30. Parents are advised not to send their children for private tuition in any subject to coaching centres / teachers. The parents can seek the help of the Principal to enroll their child in the special classes being conducted in the school after or during the school hours.

- 31. It is also to be noted that as per the rules of the school our school teachers will not entertain private tuitions at home.
- 32. Students are not permitted to bring cell phones or other electronic gadgets to school as per Government Order and our school rules. Any violation in this regard will invoke strict disciplinary action against the student.
- 33. In emergency cases wherein the mobile needs to be sent by the parent, there should be a written request from the parent and the instrument should be deposited with the school office / class teacher as soon as the child comes to the school in the morning. If this procedure is not followed the rule for non- compliance with regard to bringing electronic gadgets to school shall be applicable.
- 34. Random checking of bags shall be conducted on any day that the child is in school or in a school program. The bags can be checked for the following (i) Mobile phones; (ii) Extra books not required by students as per timetable; (iii) Story books other than school library books; (iv) Any other unwanted material etc. In case of finding unwarranted material in the bag, suitable disciplinary action shall be initiated.
- 35. Application for Transfer Certificate, signed by both the parents must be handed over at the office by the parent in person.
- 36. This School diary should be brought to school daily and entries regarding, Leave record, Daily Work, Communication, Out pass record, and other details should be duly filled in as and when required.
- 37. The presence of parents for the Parents-Teachers Meeting is highly encouraged. Kindly follow the schedule given by the class teacher for the same. Parents are requested to contact the Class/Subject teachers on other days only through the Principal/Headmistress with prior appointment.


