

In pursuance of their application as per Exhibit-19, based on the inspection report of their school and the letter as per Exhibit-20, the DAV Matriculation Higher Secondary School, Chennai-94, 162, Sivananda Road, Gill Nagar, Choolaimedu, Chennai District, Chennai, as per the Right to Free and Compulsory Education for Children from LKG to 8th Class Rules, 2011 and the Matriculation Schools Regulation Rules for Classes 9 and 12, within the jurisdiction conferred by the Government Order in Exhibit-13 and as per the Government Order (Status) No. 66, Part (MS) dated 03.08.2020 and the following conditions are hereby granted provisional continuous recognition.

- This school shall adhere to the procedures/precepts set out in the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Tamil Nadu Right to Free and Compulsory Education Act Rules, 2011.
- In the entry level class of the school, it should be ensured that not less than 25% of the total enrolment in the class is enrolled from the weaker/disadvantaged sections of the surrounding area and free compulsory education is provided to them till they complete the 8th standard.
- A separate bank account should be maintained in the name of "School Principal" to enable payment of tuition fees at the school.
- No capitation should be collected from parents, and no written test/oral interview should be conducted for admission of children.
- No child shall be denied admission on the grounds of (a) non-provision of birth certificate or place of birth (b) caste, race, religion or place of birth or any other ground.
- As per rule 23(1) of the right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009, teachers teaching from L.K.G to Class 8 shall have minimum educational and professional qualifications and shall also pass the Teacher Eligibility Test. Those who do not have these qualifications shall not be considered as fully qualified teachers. Teachers teaching from 9 to 10 shall have the minimum educational qualifications specified in the Rules for Regulation Matriculation schools.
- The school administration must ensure that the following factors are met under the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Tamilnadu Rules thereunder 201.
 - No child admitted shall be removed until he/she completes primary education (VIII class).
 - No child should be subjected to physical/mental abuse.
 - Children should not be subjected to any public examinations until they complete their primary education.
 - Children completing primary education should be given a certificate as specified in Rule No. 21.
 - admission to differently abled children / children requiring special attention should be given be made with relaxations.
 - Only teachers who have completed their studies as per Rule no.23(1) shall be appointed.
 - Teachers shall carry out their duties as defined under Sub – Rule (1) of rule no.24. The school administration should not allow any teachers to take private tuition classes.
- The curriculum approved by the Tamilnadu Board of School Education and Government Order no. 14. The three term curriculum and the continuous assessment system defined PK(X.2) department dated 19.09.2011 must be followed without failing schools.
- Definition given in section 19 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 Norms & Standards should be strictly adhered by the schools.
- The school building should be used only for Educational purposes and Educational Skill development purposes.
- A society or association registered or incorporated under the Tamilnadu Registered Societies Act, 1975 accordance with applicable law, not for the profit of groups or for the profit of individuals.
- The school should be managed by a Public Trust established in profit of individuals.

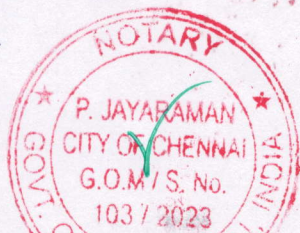

13. The school budget accounts should be duly audited by a chartered accountant and a copy should be submitted to the authorised officer. These accounts should be sent to the officers authorised to approve them manually.
14. The school administration should promptly submit the reports/information requested by the department from time to time. The school administration should strictly follow the instructions given by the administration/government from time to time to complete the school accreditation/resolve the problems arising in the school operation and ensure the continuity of the school.
15. This authorization order will be withdrawn if it is found that the laws, rules, and regulations set out in this order and the conditions imposed for authorization have been violated.
16. According to the Government Order in View-6, additional sections should be started only with the permission of the Principal Education Officer.
17. According to the Tamil Nadu Schools (Regulation of Collection of Fees) Act, 2009, the school shall collect only the fees fixed by the Fees Fixing Committee from the students.
18. Government Order No. 131 School Education (X-2) Department, all the conditions should be followed by the school administration without fail. The guidelines issued by the government regarding the norms to be followed in the interest of safety in schools should be followed without fail. Further, the instructions issued by the department from time to time, dated 10.09.2006, have been informed.
19. Classes from LKG to 3 should operate on the ground floor only.
20. No educational institution or residence, no shop with commercial purpose or any other institution shall operate in this school premises other than the school.
21. Ramps and handrails should be provided in schools and toilets for children with disabilities.
22. The proposal for continued recognition along with all relevant details and attachments should be submitted to the undersigned three months before the expiry date of this temporary continuous recognition. All the conditions as per Government Order No. 270, dated 22.10.2012 must be fulfilled.
24. Should be taught as a language subject. According to the Tamil Nadu Tamil Education Act 2006, only Tamil is taught in Part-1 from class 1 to 10.
25. Reclining seats should be provided for all students.
26. Adequate classrooms should be provided as per RTE.
27. According to Government Decree No. 270, additional urinals, drinking water taps, and handwashing taps should be provided according to the number of students.
28. After the expiry of the health certificate and the no-objection certificate issued by the fire department, the certificates should be renewed and a copy thereof should be sent with a notarized signature.
29. From 01.06.2020, when submitting a proposal for a continuous approval order, a copy of the building plan approved by the relevant officer should be attached. (Planning permission, building permission order details should be attached)
30. Health Certificate and Fire Department clearance certificate issued for the current year must be obtained and submitted.

This order is issued on the condition that the next provisional recognition can be considered only after the school administration has fulfilled the conditions mentioned in serial numbers 26 to 30 above. If the school administration fails to follow the above procedures, action will be taken to withdraw the recognition without any prior notice. The school principal is further requested to send an acknowledgement of receipt of these procedures.
